Agricultural Advisory Committee

Regional District of Nanaimo 2020-2024 Financial Plan

It was moved and seconded that pending approval from the Union of BC Municipalities, that \$50,000 from the Electoral Area G Community Works Fund be used for safety and accessibility upgrades of Little Qualicum Hall at Dashwood Community Park and that the project be added to the 2020 Financial and Parks Plan.

- 90(1)(k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public; and
- 90(1)(m) a matter that, under another enactment, is such that the public may be excluded from the meeting.
