San Malo Community Park Expenditures Report

RECOMMENDATION

That the San Malo Community Park Expenditures Report be received as information.

BACKGROUND

At the RDN In-Camera Board Meeting held on July 12, 2022, the following resolution was approved:

That the Board rise and report on the expenditures required for the remediation of San Malo Park, so that a communication can be detailed and sent to the community

In November 2019, the RDN was informed that a group of residents had used a tractor to create a bike agility course in San Malo Community Park in Electoral Area G. The result of this action was significant land alterations and disturbance to the Community Park.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

To date, the expenditures related to the remediation of San Malo Community Park are approximately \$63,333 including \$57,257 associated with professional fees and \$6,076 associated with fencing fees.

Below is a breakdown of the expenditure spent to date at San Malo Community Park since November 2019 and their corresponding funding sources.

It is important to note that the above does not include the value of staff time which has been significant over numerous budget years for all matters in relation to San Malo Community Park. This includes staff funded from Area 'G' Community Parks Operations, General Government Administration, and Strategy and Intergovernmental Services.
