A Bylaw to Amend Regional District of Nanaimo
Regional Growth Strategy Bylaw No. 1615, 2011

The Board of the Regional District of Nanaimo, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1) TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as “Regional District of Nanaimo Regional Growth Strategy Amendment Bylaw No. 1615.06, 2022”.

2) AMENDMENT

The “Regional District of Nanaimo Regional Growth Strategy Bylaw No. 1615, 2011”, is hereby amended as follows:

- a) By deleting ‘Appendix ‘A’: Map 4 – Land Use Designations’ and replacing it with Schedule ‘1’ attached to and forming part of this bylaw to make the following land use designation changes:
 - i) For the land legally described as “Lot 1, Section 14, Range 6, Cranberry District, Plan 40297 Except that Part in Plan VIP77316”, changing the land use designation from ‘Rural Residential’ to ‘Industrial’.
 - ii) For the land legally described as “Lots 1 and 2, Sections 14 and 15, Cranberry District, Plan VIP78539”, changing the land use designation from ‘Rural Residential’ to ‘Industrial’.

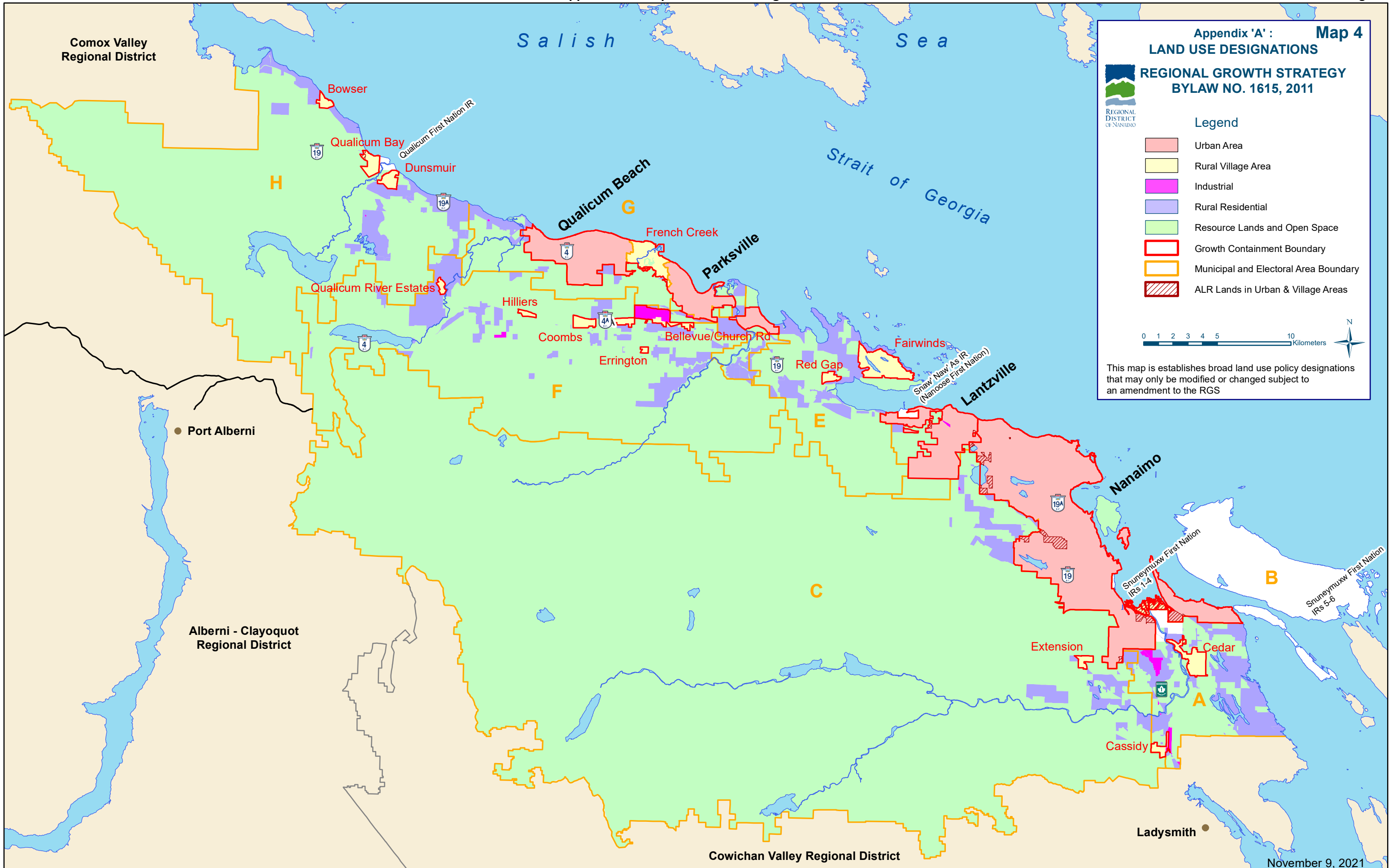
