

Meeting Type, Date, and Time: Board, June 27, 2023, 1:00 PM

Summary: The issue of cell tower influence on the health of humans and animals, including wildlife, has not been adequately addressed in the Hodges Rd cell tower plan. Canadian health authorities are propagating outdated and unfounded research conclusions to brush aside significant risk to people in the vicinity of cell towers and there is a large body of science supporting the dangers of 4G (with intention to add 5G at a later date for the Hodges tower) on living organisms. With a 5-minute presentation, I will outline the most salient research that clearly demonstrates that communities must reevaluate the risks of EMF from cell towers on humans and particularly children, who are most susceptible to ionizing and non-ionizing radiation. The necessity and convenience of cellular service in remote places, such as the 6th hole of the local golf course, must be balanced against the very significant risk of neurological disorders and cancer in exposed pregnant women, infants, children, farm animals and wildlife.

Action Requested: Moratorium on the construction of the cell tower on Hodges Rd until safety issues are resolved.
