



## Electoral Area A Recreation and Culture Grant Program- Spring 2023 Applications

**Please note: The recommendation was varied by the Committee as follows:**

- 1. That the Cedar Community Hall grant application for \$3000 for Heritage Day, Family Movie Nights and Fall Community Dinner be approved.**
- 2. That Scientist Sessions grant application be declined due to the workshops not being held in Electoral Area A.**
- 3. That the Cedar Farmers Market Agricultural Society's grant application for \$400 for Kid's Kits be approved.**
- 4. That staff review the "clause 14 - using funds for capital items" of the Electoral Area A Recreation and Culture Grant-in-Aid criteria and how it can be modified for future applications.**

### **RECOMMENDATION**

That the level of grant funding be determined for eligible applicants for the spring 2023 intake of the Electoral Area A Recreation and Culture Grant program.

### **BACKGROUND**

Electoral Area A Recreation and Culture Grant funding is available to all nonprofit organizations within the Electoral Area. Since inception, a range of sports, outdoor, artistic, cultural, and social groups have received financial support.

As of the February deadline for the spring grant intake, three grant applications were received. The combined value of the funding requests is \$3,830.00. The eligibility of the applications is to be assessed in accordance with the Electoral Area A Recreation and Culture Grant Program criteria (Attachment 1). The summary table of applications (Table 1) provides an overview of the three applications. Attachments 2 through 4 are the three individual grant applications in full.

### **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

A total of \$10,000 for recreation grant funding was approved within the 2023 Financial Plan in the Electoral Area A Recreation and Culture Service. This is the first intake for the year, the second intake deadline is in September 2023.

Table 1 provides a summary of the applications received for the February 2023 intake (Attachments 2 through 4) and includes one blank column, which can be used in discussion and calculations of grant funding amounts.
