## **REVIEW OF FALL 2018 APPLICATIONS**

The Grants Committee reviewed applications for Youth and Community Grants. Priority was given to new applicants and/or projects that benefited people in all areas of the Regional District.

The Grants Committee received four applications for Youth Grants, requesting \$8,590. All four Youth Grant applications met grant criteria and are recommended for funding for a total of \$8,590. One application from Oceanside Minor Lacrosse is recommended for funding with the caveat that a Summary Report be submitted by November 15, 2018 for the District 69 Recreation Grant received in 2015.

The Grants Committee received eight applications for Community Grants, requesting \$12,752. All eight Community Grant applications met the grant criteria and are recommended for funding for a total of \$12,752.
